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A sacrament is “an outward sign of inward grace, instituted by Christ for our salvation.” Jesus came to save us, and we can be saved *only* if we have a personal relationship with God, and God gave us the seven sacraments as help to our salvation. Every sacrament conveys that help, which we call grace, as a completely unmerited gift. There is nothing we can do to deserve God’s grace.

As the first and primary catechists for your children, we are relying on the parents to help. Modeling and sharing your faith with your family is your primary goal. However, as you walk this journey with your children you may find questions that you are unable to answer. With that, the church will be providing parent/sponsor guidance.
